High-load Crop Oil Concentrate

- CHS Sitka is a highly concentrated blend of emulsifiers and paraffin oil. The product is designed for use with a broad range of herbicides where an oil concentrate adjuvant is recommended.
- CHS Sitka increases contact activity and penetration of the spray, while also providing uniform coverage on leaf surfaces at half the use rate of a standard crop oil.
 - Typical use rates will be 0.5% v/v (2 quarts per 100 gallons of water) or 0.25% v/v (1 quart per 100 gallons of water)

FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
